# Fast Facts: Counting Stars

How many stars can you see at night?

- Hipparchus 1026
- Ptolemy **1056**
- Johannes Kepler 1005
- Galileo <u>with his telescope</u> 3310



Today, our most powerful telescopes can see
 25 sextillion stars (out of estimated 70 sextillion!)
 70,000,000,000,000,000,000,000,000
 (Equal to grains of sand on beaches of 10,000 earths!)
 (Yet, there are 100,000 times that many atoms in you!)



Milky Way galaxy, believed to contain 200-600 billion stars

Andromeda galaxy, our nearest spiral galaxy neighbor

#### Sombrero galaxy (M104) discovered in 1767
